Nobles County Sheriff's Department would like everyone to know that they will be strictly enforcing our junk vehicles and nuisance property ordinances. Junk Cars & Trucks & Junk Farm Implements Ordinance #95 states that no person shall park, keep, place or store or permit the parking or storage of a stock car, racing car or junk car or truck or junk farm implements on a public street or alley, or on any private lands or premises he or she owns, occupies or controls unless it shall be within a building on such

private premises.

This includes any vehicle which is not in operable condition, or which is partially dismantled, or which is used for sale of parts or as a source of repair or replacement parts for other vehicles, or which is kept for scrapping, dismantling, or salvage of any kind, or which is not properly licensed for operation within the state, or does not bear current registration. Ordinance #92, the "Junk Ordinance", deals with anything that is a nuisance to a property or the surrounding properties. The most common are: Accumulation of refuse or other debris. All noxious weeds and other rank growths of vegetation upon private property.

Accumulations In The Open means discarded or disused machinery, household appliances, automobile bodies, or other materials in a manner conducive to the harboring of rats, mice or vermin, or the rank growth of vegetation among the items so accumulated. Complete Ordinances are available at City Hall. The Sheriff's Department will be in touch with anyone in violation. Tickets will be issued if the problem is not taken care of within the time frame given. We hope that all residents will take notice of their properties and keep them clean. A special Thank You to the residents who already comply with our ordinances.
